

### WASTE MANAGEMENT, WATER CONSERVATION, GREEN CAMPUS AND DISABLED-FRIENDLY, BARRIER FREE ENVIRONMENT

The Institution has a green campus with plants. The campus has beautiful plants surrounded by ornamental gardens near the entrance and front office. To maintain the green campus the institution has adopted a plastic free campus.

The institution has taken necessary initiatives towards waste management. An adequate number of trash cans are placed all over the campus. The wet and dry waste are segregated and disposed of on a regular basis. Sanitary incinerators are installed inside the campus to promote hygiene. The E-waste which includes a wide range of electronic items such as computers, keyboards, printers etc., is disposed of centrally through eco-friendly vendors. 
